ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Fuse is a transfer program between the University of South Florida and St. Petersburg College. This partnership provides a seamless academic pathway for you to complete your associate degree at SPC and guarantees admission into one of the approved baccalaureate programs at USF. Fuse will save you time and money.



ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Select one of the approved majors <https://www.spcollege.edu/fuse>
2. Less than 30 college credits completed (including Dual Enrollment)
3. GPA of 2.0 or higher (Business and Engineering have higher GPA requirements)
 - a. There is no GPA requirement for incoming high school graduates without college credits
4. Completion ratio of 67% on all courses attempted
5. Ability to graduate with the AA degree (and all prerequisites for major) in 3 years or less

As part of the Fuse Program you are also required to complete college level foreign language at SPC (if required for your major), attend regular advising appointments with SPC & USF advisors, attend Fuse orientation, activities, events & workshops

High School Programs:

1. Dual Enrollment students are eligible with less than 30 credits and 2.0 or higher GPA in all college courses
2. Early Admission students will be reviewed on a case by case basis
3. Early College & Collegiate High School students ARE NOT eligible for the Fuse Program
