

Grading Policies:

Grading policies for Radiography courses are determined by each individual instructor with input from the program director. Grading policies are clearly stated in course syllabi which are given to the student prior to the first week of class. The student must achieve at least a C grade in every Radiography class and maintain a 2.0 college-wide grade point average in order to remain in the Radiography Program.

Incomplete (I) grades will only be given when the student is unable to complete a course due to extenuating circumstances. Under no circumstances will an incomplete grade be given in lieu of a grade of D or F. Incomplete grades need to be completed by the end of the following full semester or a grade of F will result.

A student may not audit a Radiography core course unless permission is granted by the program director prior to registration.

The following grading system has been adopted by the program:

Didactic Courses, Clinical Courses, and Imaging Labs:

92 to 100 = A 84 to 91 = B 75 to 83 = C 70 to 74 = D Below 70 = F

Procedures Lab Courses:

93 to 100 = A 86 to 92 = B 80 to 85 = C 75 to 79 = D Below 75 = F

90 to 100 = A 83 to 89 = B 75 to 82 = C 70 to 74 = D Below 70 = F
